SECTION III: NARRATIVE

BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

House Memorial 51 requests the formation of a committee to assess whether the public education funding formula meets the requirements of Article 13, Section 1 of the New Mexico Constitution and to report its findings to the Legislative Education Study Committee (LESC), the Legislative Finance Committee (LFC) and Governor before the 2025 Legislative Session. The committee shall be comprised of the following members: LESC, LFC, the Public Education Department, the Department of Finance and Administration, the Public School Capital Outlay Council (PSCOC) and representatives of the Public School Facilities Authority (PSFA), the New Mexico Association of School Business Officials and the New Mexico Coalition of Educational Leaders.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

Indeterminate as to the PSCOC and the PSFA.

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

The PSCOC primary function is to bring equitable state funding to build, renovate, repair school facilities statewide.

Establishing a committee of key agencies in education to assess whether the public education funding formula meets the requirements of Article 13, Section 1 of the New Mexico Constitution will assist to remedy the findings of the Martinez and Yazzie Consolidated Lawsuit and to determine whether the funding formula adequately supports the educational needs of students in New Mexico.

PERFORMANCE IMPLICATIONS

The work and commitment involved on the part of committee members will be significant and the requirement of the PSCOC and PSFA may affect the Public School Capital Outlay Act and operations of the PSFA.
