BILL SUMMARY

Synopsis:

Senate Bill 400 (SB400) appropriates \$2,500,000 to the New Mexico Public Education Department (PED) from the general fund, to redesign middle schools and junior high schools statewide in fiscal years 2024 and 2025.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

SIGNIFICANT ISSUES

SB400 appropriates funding to redesign middle schools and junior high schools statewide. The bill does not state the purpose of redesigning the schools, or define what will be redesigned. The PSFA assumed the bill was intended to redesign the middle school and junior high school facilities until the intent of the bill was clarified by LESC staff.
